

MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY DLOs' MEETING HELD ON THE 3RD SEPTEMBER, 2014 AT 11:00 A.M. IN DC OFFICE/TAMENGLONG CHAIRED BY SHRI C. ARTHUR W (IAS), DEPUTY COMMISSIONER TAMENGLONG.

OFFICERS/MEMBERS PRESENT: (Attendance sheet attached as Annexure-1)

At the outset, Deputy Commissioner Tamenglong welcomed all the members present. The meeting reviewed the reports from the Departments which are noted as follows:-

1	CAF & PD:	<p>DC/Tamenglong asked the DSO (CAF & PD) if the updation regarding prioritisation of AAY in respect of Tamei sub-division is also complete as the other sub-divisions. Shri Gonjeng Pamei, DSO (CAF & PD) reported that all the sub-divisions have completed the updation. Further, DC/Tamenglong apprised the DLOs that in view of the bandh imposed on the National Highways by the UNC, there is possibility of scarcity of essential commodities especially foodgrains for which the district administration need to take stock of the situation by controlling price rise, hoarding of goods and POL available in the district including the outlying sub-divisions. DC asked the DSO (CAF & PD) to work on the availability of staff to be detailed for rationing/inspection of shops and IOC retail outlets in the district. A team of officers including the DSO (CAF & PD) and staff will inspect the godown of local shopkeepers to ascertain the stock position of foodgrains. The staff to be deputed at the Oil Pumps in Tamenglong, Tamei and Noney for rationing the sale of POL are to be assisted by 5-6 VDF personnel. The SP/Tamenglong is requested to ensure the arrangement of VDF personnel for assisting the staff to be detailed by DC Office. Further, the DSO (CAF & PD) will issue coupons for purchase of foodgrains in the shops and POL at the oil pumps. The SDO/Nungba and Tamei will detail staff from their offices at their respective oil pumps for rationalising the sale of POL products.</p> <p>Further, DC asked the SDC (HQ) to put up the order for detailing the staff to be stationed for checking the sale</p>
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		<p>of POL at the Oil Pump in Tamenglong HQ. The DSO (CAF & PD) will also issue necessary orders to his staff for checking the sale register at the shops in the bazaar.</p> <p>Further, rice should be sold @ 5 kg per family per day and POL @ 2 litres for two/three wheeler and 5 litres for LMV (light motor vehicles) per day.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><u>/Action: AC to DC & all DLOs/</u></p>
2	WILD LIFE SANCTUARY:	<p>DC enquired the DFO (WFD) to give the action taken report regarding the steps taken so far for declaration of the proposed Zeilad area of Tamenglong district as a Wild Life Sanctuary. The DFO said that so far only Zeiladjang village has given consent while Atengba village which has bigger area within the proposed region has not yet given consent. DC told the DFO (WFD) that if the involvement of SDOs are required for interaction with the villagers the SDOs will also be roped in to expedite the matter. DC asked the DFO to fix a date for discussion with the concerned SDOs. In order to avoid disputes, claims and withdrawal of consent in the future DC apprised that due care should be taken because quite often the land acquisition processes are held up mid-way due to disputes arising after reaching an advanced stage after a long periods usually 8-10 months wasting much exhaustive effort.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><u>/Action: DFO (WFD), SDOs-Tamenglong & Tousem/</u></p>
3	NIC:	<p>DC enquired Shri Kikhon Pamei who represented the DIO (NIC) to check if any more departments are left out from the District Website due to non-submission of details by the concerned Department. DIO (NIC) is instructed to submit the list of pending departments.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><u>/Action: DIO-NIC/</u></p>
4	ZEO:	<p>With regard to the instruction of government for arranging the students of the schools including the JNV and KV to have a video call session with the Prime Minister the following points were noted:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ZEO, Tamenglong will send the photos of the ongoing class session.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The JNV has made necessary arrangement. However, they need diesel to run the generator. The principal requested DC to help him in providing diesel for the generator. - The KV has no cable connection but they can use that of the Tamenglong Hr. Sec. School alternatively as discussed with the Principal. <p style="text-align: right;"><u>/Action: ZEO, Principal KV, JNV, THSS/</u></p>
5	Tamenglong College:	<p>DC asked the Principal of Tamenglong college if there is any improvement after the recent check on the attendance of lecturers in the classes. The attendance check was taken up by DC Office after complaints were received from student organisations. The Principal said that as of now, the classes are more regular than before and the attendance has improved.</p>
6	Electricity/MSPDCL:	<p>The DGM/MSPDCL is represented by Shri Kachanlak and he was enquired why there is no electricity in Tamenglong today he said that the 11 KV line from Tamei can be loaded within a few hours. Due to the low voltage of this line the load shedding is done with current every two nights/day for the transmission lines of the town.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><u>/Action: DGM-MSPDCL-TML/</u></p>
7	T.O:	<p>Shri Chingkhiulung Rianmei, ATO pointed out that some departments are yet to complete TAN and it should be submitted on or before 10th September without fail. Further, DC asked the ATO to give the list of defaulting departments for taking necessary action.</p> <p>Further, DC asked the DLOs if they are aware of an instruction from Government to start processing the Govt. employee's pension papers six months ahead of the retiring date. DC apprised all the DLOs to take note of it for compliance.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><u>/Action: All DLOs, TO-Tml/</u></p>
8	DACO:	<p>Dr. Z. Kamei requested DC/Tamenglong to demarcate the compound of the Medical Department and his quarter as the compound is not clearly demarcated due to lack of plot allotment orders and the</p>

		<p>encroachers are taking advantage of this situation which could lead to problems regarding the medical department land in the future. The matter is to be studied by SDC/BO regarding allotment details etc.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><u>/Action: SDC-BO/</u></p>
9	PHED:	<p>The EE/PHED apprised that National Awareness week is being organised from 26th September onwards. Further, regarding the request of the public for construction of one public toilet under TSC near the UBS area he said that land development is required. DC apprised that the land development can be done either TSC itself or MGNREGA. This may be tied up with SDO/BDO Tamenglong.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><u>/Action: EE-PHED, SDO-Tml/</u></p>
