

PROCEEDINGS OF DRDA GOVERNING BODY MEETING HELD ON THE 3RD
JUNE, 2014 AT 2:30 P.M. IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM OF HOTEL CLASSIC,
IMPHAL CHAIRED BY SHRI HUMALIABOU, HON'BLE CHAIRMAN, DRDA,
TAMENGLONG.

At the outset , the Chairman welcome all the members present and thanked the members for attending the GBM. He initiated discussion while highlighting the agenda given below:-

1. MGNREGS:

The Projected and actual Achievement under MGNREGA since 2012-13 in respect of DRDA, Tamenglong District, Manipur, was deliberated minutely in the meeting and observed seriously the wide gap between the projected and actual receipt of fund especially

in 2013-14 wherein the District could achieved only 35 man-days. The DPC apprised the GBM that this was mainly due to 3 factors.

1. Paucity of release from the Centre to State and then to the District.
2. Distribution of fund from the State to the District was almost evenly done based on the number of job cards and not on performance, so for district like Tamenglong, which has less number of Job Cards, who performed both on field level and on MIS was not benefitting. Though there was demand for work the district could only utilized such fund received from the state for the purpose. The district should have been getting more fund because one of the factors for getting fund is the progress of MIS reporting wherein the district top the list in 2012-13 and in 2013-14, achieved 99.35%.
3. Current year fund distribution system of funds from the Centre to the State Finance and then to the SEGF and from there to the district is really going to hinder the progress of the implementation of the scheme.

The delay in fund release by the state to the district was also discussed, the meeting also mentioned about the creation of new Account Head by Finance Dept. and it was pointed out by the Hon'ble members that unless fund is release to the district at the earliest the poor people of the district will face starvation as the rainy season arrives.

On the proposal of the Hon'ble Vice-Chairman (HAC) the meeting adopted a resolution to request the concerned to fall back to the past pattern of direct fund release to the district from the Centre in order to avoid delay in fund release and to mitigate the problems of food shortage district like Tamenglong, where the people uses MGNREGS wage money as the only source of sustenance for procuring rice during rainy season before harvest of their jhum field.

On the issue of 25% for the Hon'ble members of the ADC, the meeting discussed in detail the feasibility and difficulty in implementing on practical issues because of the paucity and uncertainty in fund release. It was decided to go phase-wise to see if it can be done for which Hon'ble Chairman ADC/DRDA will call a meeting once fund is released from the state.

2. IAY.

Target and achievement under IAY was presented to the members present in the meeting. The State Govt. has not yet released its share for 2013-14 till today. The following points were noted with regard to implementation of IAY in the district:-

The meeting discussed issues regarding Permanent Wait List (PWL) for updating PWL and apprised the House about Awasoftware. Further, it was agreed that PWL will be updated by the concerned BDOs in consultation with the VAs and Hon'ble ADCs, which will be put up before the GBM for approval. This process must be completed within August, 2024.

The meeting also apprised the house that except for Tamenglong block no other blocks have submitted the A/C No. of the beneficiary for the year 2013-14. All other blocks are reminded to submit the same at the earliest.

The meeting also discussed about the status of IAY recipient of victim of fire/ natural calamities and for exemption from norms provided with Awasoftware on which it was decided to raise the issue to the State Vigilance and Monitoring Meeting scheduled on 11th June, 2014. Separate instruction in this regard is being issued and MPO Bantim is to pursue the matter.

3. BRGF:

The meeting discussed in detail the progress of implementation under BRGF. It was decided that BDOs will monitor the progress of works and see how action can be taken to speed up the work's progress of pending works. Works list to be provided to them by DA/BRGF.

The meeting also decided to ensure that there is no overlapping of works and to reduce the work items so that only works of public utility is taken up.

The meeting apprised the members that no water tank is constructed/ built at the water source, rather water source should be made the water reservoir so that water did not dried up. Further, the earlier system of fund distribution for the district will apply.

4. MSDP:

The meeting discussed thread bare on the issue of non-release of state share, because of which it may not be possible to pay the final bill. So it resolved to give full final bill amount from the State Share to be released to only those who have completed because there is a deficit of around 2 crore already. The meeting further resolved to pursue the state share because it will not be possible to submit the UC without it for 2010-11. Further, Vigilance department must also be approached to seek the status of pending cases (if any). Thereafter fund can be released to the work agencies.

5. IWMP

The meeting discussed in detail the physical and financial achievement presented to the house in the meeting. Members were well satisfied with the implementation of the scheme in the district. The meeting call upon to implement the scheme in close coordination with the members of the ADC. A meeting for DWDC (District Watershed Development Committee) will be held on June 12, 2014 to be chaired by Hon'ble Chairman (ADC/DRDA) to closely monitor the progress. It was brought out that certain villages are having problem due to confusion in WC membership. It was further reiterated that those approved in the DPR will continue Sempat Naga, Mongjarong Khunou, Duiluan (Wairangba), Tatbung, Muktokhal, Magulong where the WDT members will reverify the status for making necessary changes.

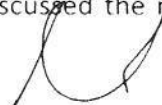
6. NRLM:

The meeting appraised the house that DRDA, Tamenglong, have closed SGSY account and subsequently submitted closing certificate issued by the Manager, UBI, Tamenglong, to the Government as directed. However, NRLM is yet to be implemented in the district.

7. DRDA ADMINISTRATION:

It was discussed and observed in the meeting the nature of fund flow from the state to the district is going to impact the DRDA employees. It was reported that an amount of Rs.29,52,000/- released by the Centre under DRDA Administration is lying with the State Finance Department.

Unless funds are receive timely by the district and utilised, subsequently claim for further instalment will be difficult. The meeting discussed the need for coordination of all



the members including Hon'ble Chairman and Hon'ble MLAs on this issue and to apprise the matter before the upcoming SLVMC meeting scheduled on 11th June, 2014.

8. MISCELLANEOUS

- I. The meeting discussed on the issue relating to the visits of NLM to 3 blocks namely, Khoupum, Nungba and Tousem blocks from 5th June to 9th June, 2014.
- II. The meeting also discussed the issues of difficulty of the district for transition to eFMs because of factors such as poor internet connectivity, road, electricity, banking facility among others.

After successful deliberation of vital issues and drawing of resolutions for the smooth implementation of schemes under the DRDA, Tamenglong, the Chairman thanked all the members present and the meeting was closed.
